## Declaration Honoring Chancellor Phil DiStefano October 19, 2023

Phil DiStefano joined the university in 1974 as an assistant professor of curriculum and instruction in the School of Education. He has since seen the university from nearly every perspective, as a parent, donor, professor, dean, provost and - since his appointment in 2009 - chancellor.

As chancellor, Dr. DiStefano has worked closely with students, faculty, staff, alumni and donors as well as industry and community leaders in extending CU Boulder's legacy as a preeminent national comprehensive research university. His strategic imperatives for the campus are to shape tomorrow's leaders, be the top university for innovation and to positively impact humanity.
